
After many months of work, this Sunday January 26 at 10:00am, we will cut the ribbon and dedicate our new Children's Ministry Center in the Bell Building downtown!

I stumbled into this poem "Those Winter Sundays" by Robert Hayden twice in the past few months. ¹First, I think it was referenced at one of the talks at our Mockingbird conference here in Tyler in September, and then I noticed a reference to it again recently while reading Abigail Shrier's *Bad Therapy*.

The poem is a really lovely homage to Hayden's father, with whom he seems to have a bit of a complicated relationship. With the privilege of hindsight, Hayden can see the love that his father showed him in ways that he didn't recognize at the time. He writes,

Sundays too my father got up early

and put his clothes on in the blueblack cold,

then with cracked hands that ached

from labor in the weekday weather made

banked fires blaze. No one ever thanked him.

Hayden can see that the warmth and comfort he took for granted was actually the result of the effort of his father, effort that went unremarked and unnoticed. Hayden goes to write,

Speaking indifferently to him,

who had driven out the cold

and polished my good shoes as well.

What did I know, what did I know

of love's austere and lonely offices?

I love this last line especially, "love's austere and lonely offices." It seems that Jesus' disciples benefited form "love's austere and lonely offices" without really grappling with the full extent of what he did for them.

Moreover, I suspect that all of us as Christians have experienced the benefits of "love's austere and lonely offices", not only in the care of our parents, but in youth leaders, Sunday school teachers, and pastors. So many members in our churches do vital ministry that is not often noticed.

I am reminded of the way in my own youth group, the lights were always on, the space was always set up and put together. Which saintly parishioner made sure all of this happened week-in and week-out? I pray that I would notice "love's austere and lonely offices" in others, and that I too might be able to carry them in my own way.

You will not want to miss this event.


